

## **Agreement Establishing Collaboration between the Board of Canadian Registered Safety Professionals and the Canadian Association for Black Health and Safety Professionals**

The Board of Canadian Registered Safety Professionals (BCRSP) and the Canadian Association for Black Health and Safety Professionals (CABHSP) recognize the benefits of a collaborative partnership to improve safety and health in workplaces and the development of occupational health and safety practitioners at all levels.

BCRSP and CABHSP hereby form a partnership to use their collaborative efforts and expertise to improve health and safety in workplaces and to encourage individuals working in OHS to pursue the advancement of their career through certification, mentorship, and lifelong learning.

It is agreed between the BCRSP and CABHSP to work together to:

- Support the recognition and achievement of BCRSP occupational health and safety certifications.
- Identify opportunities for shared projects and collaboration to advance the occupational health and safety profession.
- Exchange research data, organizational data, and statistics to promote health and safety

CABHSP will publicly endorse BCRSP certifications and promote recognition that the BCRSP certifications are designed to elevate professional standards and distinguish those who meet a formal education requirement and ongoing practical experience that are essential for the effective practice of occupational health and safety. The CRSP and CRST are certifications of distinction that are awarded to candidates who meet rigorous and impartial standards.


The BCRSP and the CABHSP will seek opportunities for shared projects and collaboration to remove systemic barriers for safety professionals and promote inclusion & advancement for black health and safety professionals.

This Agreement is non-exclusive and shall not prohibit BCRSP or CABHSP from entering into agreements with other organizations.

Primary contacts for this agreement will be the current Chairpersons of each organization, supported by the Executive Directors of BCRSP and CABHSP (if applicable).

This agreement becomes effective upon signature by representatives of both parties and will remain in effect until one or both parties give 90-days written notice of intent to terminate or modify the agreement.
